Furthermore, we offer a wide range of books for general reading, competitive examination preparation, and enhancing soft skills. The library operates from 10:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. on all working days and is maintained by supportive team members.

The institute library operates under an Open Access System, featuring double-facing racks that house books organized by subject and number. Display boards are strategically placed to assist users in locating materials.

The library provides a comprehensive collection of 3448 volumes of books, encompassing 703 titles, that fulfill the needs of B.Pharmacy program as well as general books for competitive exams, spiritual magazines, and student's mental abilities. In addition, the library subscribes to numerous e-journals, national and international journals, periodicals, newspapers, project reports from undergraduate students, previous years' question papers, and books related to competitive exams.
